### **Think on these things**

#### **Kindness**

Jesus himself was the kindest man who ever lived. It is said of him, and it is said of no other in history, that if all the deeds of kindness that he did in three short years were written, the world would not contain the books (John 21:25).

Jesus talked a great deal about kindness, just the plain, old fashioned everyday habit of common kindness.

Judging by what he said, he would rather see that in his followers than any other trait of character. Not that our kindness will save us. If we are ever saved, He saves us. But there are things in us that please or displease him.

Jesus put so much stress on this thing of kindness that he identifies himself with those who need it, and in effect tells us that we cannot be friends with him and at the same time be indifferent to the suffering (Mt. 25:40,45).

He intimates that heaven will be inhabited exclusively by those who have learned how to be kind and only kind and always kind. Jesus came to build a world of beings like himself, and when completed no others will be there (Mt. 25:34, 41).

He further intimates that there are going to be some surprises in the Day of Judgment. Some who have been accustomed to think of themselves as very religious are going to find out, after it is too late, that they have been altogether overlooking the things the recording angels have been taking down (Mt 25:44).

Jesus further makes the remarkable statement that not one single act of kindness, no matter how small, will, in the economy of God's government of the universe, ever go unrewarded (Mt. 10:42).

## Criticism

Before we engage in the arrogant practice of fault finding, we ought to do the following:

1. **PAUSE AND BE SURE THAT MY HEART IS RIGHT!** Do I really want to help or hinder? Which will I be doing? Read Matt. 7:1, 2.
2. **EXAMINE MY OWN LIFE TO SEE THAT EVERYTHING IS IN ORDER!** Would I be honest to condemn another when correction is needed for my own soul? Read Matt. 7:3, 4.
3. **TRY TO PUT MYSELF IN HIS PLACE!** How would I be doing if I were bearing his burden or laboring in his place? Read Romans 15:1, 2.
4. **REMEMBER GOD'S MERCY TOWARD ME!** How often have I bowed before him to plead for grace when I have failed? Should I not be as merciful to a fellow sinner? Read Matt. 18:23-35.
5. **CONSIDER THE BENEVOLENCE OF OTHERS!** My brethren have often borne with my failures; therefore can I not now suffer with another? Read Gal. 6:1, 2.
6. **REMEMBER THE HURT I FELT THE LAST TIME SOMEONE CRITICIZED ME!** Can I delight in inflicting the same hurt upon another? Read Matt. 5:44-48.
7. **PRAY FOR MY BROTHER AND MYSELF!** I need to petition the Father for myself, that I might be forgiven for even considering sinning against him. Read Acts 8:22.
8. **GO TO MY BROTHER IN HUMILITY AND LOVE!** There I can confess my shortcomings before him and open his eyes to his own need for repentance. Read James 5:16
